## Behaviour Management Policy

### Policy Statement

All members of the school community accept the responsibility to promote an effective Behaviour Management Plan through a system of positive relationships, rules and consequences designed to progressively develop self-discipline and respect. All parents, students, staff and visitors to our school community are to be treated with respect, dignity and compassion.

### Description

Our aim is to develop the whole person - spiritually, physically, emotionally, socially, and intellectually - both as an individual and as a member of a caring Christian Community where Christ's teachings are central. We acknowledge the importance that Behaviour Management plays in shaping one's social responsibility and personal identity.

# Implementation Issues

1. Each class will create a safe, caring, respectful, inclusive and supportive environment.
2. Classroom teachers, along with their class, will develop classroom rules.
3. The consequences of behaviour and the procedures to be followed will be clearly stated.
4. Staff training will be provided to maintain and develop skills aligned to positive behaviour management consistent with the school policy.
5. Effective systems will be implemented to monitor and report behaviour throughout the school community. Parents will be informed about recurring behaviour problems and will be involved in the collaborative process to develop strategies for the solution of these problems.
6. The staff of St Mary's will support the Behaviour Management Plan that documents rules, responsibilities and procedures promoting Christian behaviour within the school.
7. The parent community of St Mary's will support this Behaviour Management Plan by developing a partnership aimed at nurturing self-discipline and acceptable behaviour in their children.
8. The children of our school community, by adhering to the Behaviour Management Plan, will
  - Accept their responsibilities and respect their rights
  - Respect the rights of all members of our school community
